At larger venues, a little reverb on vocals and snare would be appreciated. Definitely NO delay on voice!

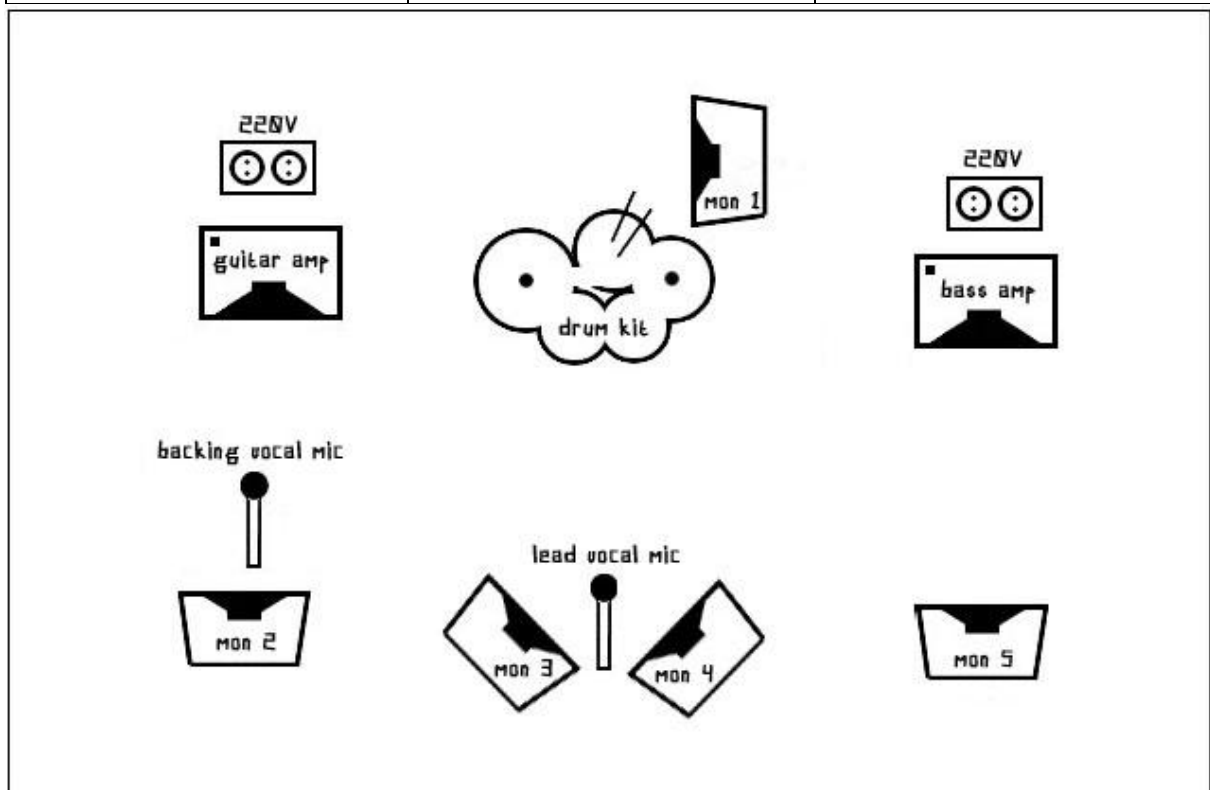
In any venue that does not technically exclude it or is not so small that there is no way to walk through it during a gig, lead vocals will use wireless headset microphone (EW D ME3 G4-B-EU). All band-members may use in-ear monitoring (EW IEM G4-B). Sennheiser EW-series base stations for both provided by Yoghurt. In-ear monitoring needs 2 jackplug stereo ins (preferably with foh-endsound), wireless headset microphone base station connects through 1 XLR-microphone cable. Yoghurt provides power adapter for both base stations but needs 1 electric point for it.
